Program Overview:

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for this program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a faculty member or scientist.
- Should have a background in a relevant field of biotechnology or a related discipline.
- Applicants from both academic and research institutions are welcome.

Application Process:

Please follow these steps to complete your registration:

- Review the list of partnering institutions and the topics they offer training in.
 Carefully choose the program and institute that aligns with your interests and qualifications.
- The link for registration will be available in the website of KSCSTE and the respective partnering institution.
- Carefully fill out all required fields in the registration form. Ensure that you indicate your preferred training program and institute.
- Each applicant is allowed to enrol in a single course using one application. If a faculty desires to apply for an additional course, a new application must be submitted.
- An application fee of Rs. 750 is to be paid.
- Pay close attention to the submission deadlines. Late applications will not be accepted.
- Gather all necessary supporting documents, which may include scanned copies of educational certificates and a passport-sized photograph.
- Submit the completed registration form along with the supporting documents as per the instructions provided in the registration form.

Selection Process:

Applicants will be selected based on their qualifications, relevant experience, and the availability of seats in the program. Please note that meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee admission.

Confirmation of Admission:

Selected candidates will be notified via email or other specified communication channels.

Program Duration:

The program duration is 14 days, with the schedule provided upon admission.

Accommodation during Training:

Accommodation arrangements will be at the discretion of the partner institutions. Participants are advised to contact the specific partnering institute for details on accommodation during the training period.

For Information:

There will be multiple sets of trainings offered by each institute in a single year. Selection/rejection and allocation of an applicant who applied to a specific programme in an institute, to a particular training set, is the discretion of KSCSTE. The applicant should submit the hard copies of the application through proper channel to the concerned course coordinator, if selected. TA/DA will be paid to the participants based on eligibility. KSCSTE tries to accommodate maximum number of applicants. If the number of participants for a particular programme is higher than the yearly target given to it, KSCSTE will try to accommodate the participants in the institute with lesser number of applicants and running the training in a closer subject area. Since Skill Vigyan Programme runs for 3 years, if applicants are more, few may be allotted to the second year.
